## Trinity Lutheran Church Voter's Meeting Minutes June 28, 2015

The Voter's Meeting was called to order by Cheri Carsten at 1: 05 pm and opened with a short devotion and prayer led by Larry Whitney. Larry said that the budget is an item of concern but know that with God, all things are possible.

A total of 40 voting members signed the registration sheets. A quorum was established.

The minutes of the November 30, 2014 Voters Meeting were made available to members prior to the meeting. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously on a voice vote by the voters present.

Board Reports: Reports from the Boards were not given at this meeting.

**Budget Presentation:** A copy of the 2015-2016 budget was made available to members prior to the meeting. Cheri Carsten opened the budget presentation by introducing committee members, Jerry Henkel, Sharon Andrews, and Debi Roethemeyer. Jerry noted three increases in the budget this year: maintenance, computer updates, and general salary increases as well as a decrease in offerings so far this year. A motion was made and seconded to approve the SWOT Resolution. The motion passed with a majority voice vote by the voters present.
