We trained the students to keep quiet and listen for instructions from their teachers. Afterward, Officer Brad gave the kiddos a high-five! It is important that we allow our children to talk about the drill, and any fears or worries they have. Encourage them to seek out a trusted grown-up, not a group of kids to talk about this. No need to go into details with small children, but do reassure them that they have grown-ups in their lives who know what to do to keep them safe. Congratulate them on doing a great job with the intruder drill at school. Remind them that they are smart kids: Now they know what to do and they are good listeners!
