



In this joyful spirit we have a great opportunity, again this year, to recognize and support our men and women in uniform who are

so easily forgotten serving this country in dangerous places throughout the world. Some families are greatly stressed by the number of deployments their loved ones have served and continue to serve. Faith Comes By Hearing is a wonderful mission, headquartered in Albuquerque, New Mexico, that provides BibleSticks to our military personnel and their families. Just \$25 provides a Military BibleStick (the Audio Drama New Testament and selected Psalms) for one of the Troops who protect our nation and preserve our freedoms. A BibleStick is smaller than the size of your thumb but has all of this information on it which offers the opportunity for soldiers to actually be in the heat of battle and be listening to God's Word at the same time through the headphones that are so small they can fit under their helmets! Thus far, since this ministry has begun, Faith Comes By Hearing, has shipped 1,116,806 BibleSticks stateside and all over the world! We, our Trinity Family, are very blessed to have contributed \$21,097.00 to this ministry since we began our local support in 2013! This translates into 843 BibleSticks! Think about that number; at least 843 soldiers have been blessed to hear the Word of God through this means as a result of your generous offerings given to this ministry. Lindy and I had the opportunity to visit their headquarters, tour their facilities and personally meet our person representative, Ann Simmons. We were so blessed to be affirmed by them in being one of their largest individual supporters of this great work. By "we" I mean Trinity Lutheran Church and School. They are so very thankful for you and all of our Trinity family.

This year we have the opportunity to continue this great support. Each Sunday, through the month of May, you will hear different presentations about this ministry and your opportunity to give. May is a big month for military recognition including VE Day, Armed Forces Day and Memorial Day; just to mention a few. Our goal, traditionally, has been to supply 100 soldiers with BibleSticks. This translates into a total offering of \$2500. Will you prayerfully consider giving an offering to this powerful (the power of God's Word) ministry during the month of May? It would be great to invite friends and neighbors who desire to support our troops to have the opportunity to participate as well.

We also have a **special worship / concert event** coming to Trinity this month; **Wednesday, May 15th at 7pm.** Mark your calendar for (date). I thank my God every time I remember you. Philippians 1:3

A World War II ambulance driver remembered finding a dead GI on a battlefield with a half-eaten candy bar in his hand. The saying, "In the midst of life we are in death" certainly applies to those who face death in battle. How quickly we can be snatched from the midst of life into eternity.

On Memorial Day we honor those who gave their lives for their country. We recall the times and circumstances which made it necessary for citizens to answer the call to duty. If they were members of our Christians families, we feel much closer to them as partners with us in the Gospel.

As we recall the past, especially as we remember our loved ones, we do the next thing: Give thanks. We cannot convey our gratitude to the dead, but we can to those still alive. Above all, we thank God for all His blessings and for having given our country many dedicated men and women who offered military support to the land.

The message of Memorial Day applies also to us as Christian citizens. We need confidence, especially in times of peril, that the work God has begun in us, in bringing us to faith in Jesus Christ, He will bring to completion when we come before Him, either on the day of our death or on the day of Christ's return. As Christian people, we are involved in "defending and confirming the Gospel" (Philippians 1:7) — the gospel of peace with God through the reconciling work of Jesus Christ, this gift of salvation we accept in faith.

The more we are involved in proclaiming and practicing Christ's gospel of peace with God, the greater will be peace on earth regardless of war.

Pray with the psalmist that God may make "wars cease to the ends of the earth" (Psalm 46:9)

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 10:10 a.m.


The meeting closed with prayer by Gary Klipp. The next meeting of the Executive Council will be held on May 11 at 8:30 a.m.




