



- 4. Playground upgrade has been done.
- 5. Hiring of a new custodian at the school has been completed.
- 6. Upcoming work includes light replacements in the school gym and Fellowship Hall.

#### **The Board of Education Ministries**

- 1. Linda indicated Vacation Bible School averaged 60 students per day.
- 2. All staffing is in place.
- 3. We are now involved in CCAP (Colorado Childcare Assistance Program).
- 4. Involvement also in CATCH program free training through Weld County Health Dept.
- 5. Early Childhood-Preschool enrollment is nearly 40 students. K-8: 36 students enrolled.






