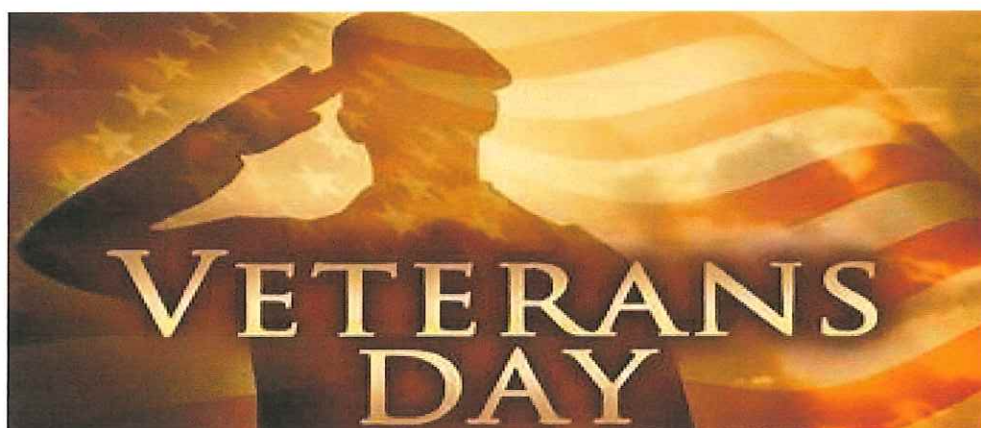

Thankfulness – a Surprise?

Then Jesus answered, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?” Luke 17:17

Sometimes a person’s thank-you comes as a surprise. And old joke goes, “A man gave a woman his seat on a bus. She fainted. When she came to, she thanked him, and he fainted.”

We might be surprised that of the 10 lepers Jesus healed, only one returned to thank Him. That grateful one was a Samaritan, a member of a deprived race. “Where are the other nine?” Jesus asked. In the excitement of their healing they may have hurried home to families and friends, quite forgetful of Jesus, their Healer.

Ingratitude, at its various levels, is a common human failing. We ourselves must plead guilty of it. It is easy to take things for granted, not realizing that all blessings flow from God – food, clothing, home, and the like. It is God who provides all our possessions by giving us health and strength to work. The prophet Isaiah voices the Lord’s complaint at Israel’s thoughtlessness: “The ox knows its owner, and the donkey its master’s crib, but Israel does not know, my people do not understand.” (Isaiah 1:3)

Thanksgiving pleases God and lifts up our own hearts and minds. With thanksgiving goes praise to God in recognition of His goodness. Being aware of this moves our hearts, adding joy to our gratitude.

We have so much to be thankful for, especially God’s giving of His Son, Jesus Christ. St. Paul said it well: “In Him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight.” (Ephesians 1:7-8) We have good reason to sing, “Come, you faithful people, come.”

Minutes of the September 14 Executive Council meeting were approved.

Treasurer Report Vicki presented and the Board approved the financial report.

Board Reports

The Board of Elders and Spiritual Ministries

1. The elders approved Mission Circle to host a "Honey Sunday" (likely 11/24) wherein proceeds from the sale of honey will go to the Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch.
2. Elders also approved Mission Circle giving out bookmarks and flyers on Sunday, November 3 for the International Day of Prayer.

The Board of Property Ministries

1. Dan reported that asphalt repairs have been completed at the school.
2. A new convection oven has been installed in the Fellowship Hall kitchen.
3. Dan met with all parties involved in bringing the upstairs of the school up to code and planning continues.
4. The Parent Teacher League has purchased two new drinking fountains for the school (old fountains were leaking beyond repair).

The Board of Education Ministries

1. Linda advised the board has their next meeting scheduled for October 14, with discussions to center on scholarships and marketing.
2. An additional student has been enrolled in 6th grade.
3. The Fall Festival is upcoming on October 26.
4. Basketball will begin soon, with our Trinity students competing with Greeley Recreation teams.
5. Cooks Night Out will be on October 22 at Red Robin.

The Board of Financial and Stewardship Ministries

1. Vicki handed out income and expense figures through September 30, 2019. Cash flow is adequate at this time.

Old Business:

Council has approved a Facility Use Policy. The procedures in this policy will apply from now on. Copies are available in the church office.

New Business:

The next voters' meeting will be Sunday, December 8 at 12:30, with a light lunch immediately after the second church service. Pam Clavir will head up the Nominating Committee as we seek a new vice president and treasurer.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m. The meeting closed with prayer by Gary Klipp, and The Lord's Prayer by all. The next meeting of the Executive Council will be held on November 9 at 8:30 a.m.

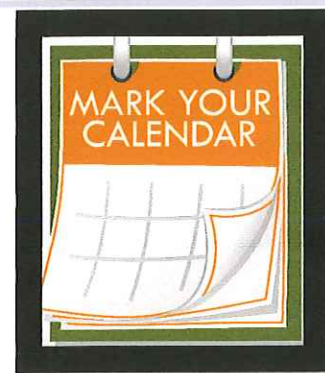

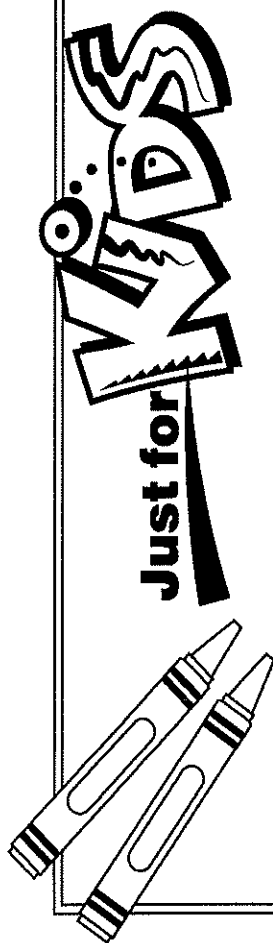
