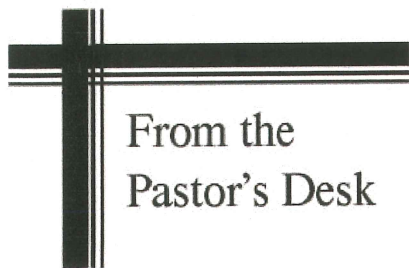


Please watch your bulletins and June Newsletter for updates to whether these groups will meet in June, or if they are on hiatus until September.

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Trinity Family,

Grace, mercy and peace be to you from God, our Father, and from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.

We know that old saying that *we fail to appreciate something until we no longer have that something available to us*. The “something” that I am thinking of at this moment is *fellowship*. I have come to appreciate all the more God’s Word recorded in Hebrews 10:25; “*Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing,*

*but let us encourage one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching.*” Lindy and I have a big empty spot in our hearts not being able to be with you in worship and after worship, shaking hands and hugging one another as we say our goodbyes for another week! Being in the physical presence of one another is so powerful for us as God’s precious children. We are family in His name. We miss being in those smaller groups to pray together, discuss God’s Word together and to encourage one another. Currently, Satan is having a heyday. But, remember, he has already been defeated. We have just celebrated, again, the historical event which defeated him; Good Friday and Easter!

In recent sermons I have expressed the connection of our current situation to the times of the early church. On Easter many were *isolated* because of fear. As the church began to grow there were no sanctuaries where Christians could gather to worship so they worshiped in small groups in their homes. I remember when I was attending Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, Indiana and visited one of our mission congregations in the country just east of the city. It was Amish country. As you drove through the countryside on a Sunday morning most yards would have no activity. Then, you would come upon a yard that was packed with buggies and the corrals packed with horses. It was evident that this particular family was hosting worship for that Sunday. In our current *isolation* we can still worship together as a household or individually with our Trinity family via the radio broadcast, KFKA 1310 AM (9:00 am, Sundays); Facebook and/or our website: [www.tlsgreeley.org](http://www.tlsgreeley.org). It is amazing that God has provided the technology necessary for us to still be able to worship *together* even when we are under the current “shelter in place” order.

Even though these are difficult and confusing times filled with many unknowns (Do you feel like you are a character in a fiction novel?) we are blessed as God’s children to live in the security of the absolute knowns; God’s absolute Truth as revealed in His inerrant Word, the Holy Bible. As Satan attempts to have his heyday God continues to overcome his (Satan’s) influence through the preaching and teaching of His (God’s) absolute truth. If the statistics be known, I would conjecture that more people have been hearing the Gospel in the last month throughout the world than any time in the history of the world. Many congregations are streaming their services in our area and throughout the world. The awesome thing about streaming is that the streamed message literally is offered around the world. For example, one of our recent streamed services received a positive comment from a Christian in Indonesia! God is so AWESOME!

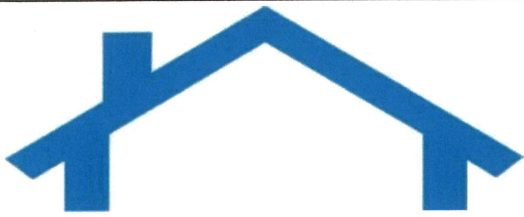
I am asking you to pray for the Church, the Body of Believers, locally and around the world that we may continue to be faithful to God’s Word and not submit to the sinful desires of the world. Pray that God will guide us as to when we should gather physically again for worship on site at Trinity. Praise God for the technology available to us to be able to stay connected and to continue to encourage and uplift one another’s spirits. Make the effort daily to call other people, especially those who are all alone in their homes, and pray with them and provide whatever help they may need. Pray that God would humble this nation through this event in such a way that people would be humbled to acknowledge Him, repent, and receive His mercy. Pray for a revival in this land.

Did you notice that not only does God instruct us to *not give up meeting together* but also to *encourage one another – and all the more AS YOU SEE THE DAY APPROACHING*. *The Day* is judgment day; the day that our Lord returns. Yes, the end of the world. Many are contemplating whether these are signs of the very end times. My personal opinion is that the world has never experienced an event like the one we currently are experiencing. Would you have ever imagined that the economies of the world could be shut down in less than a couple of weeks!? This gets my attention; not in a frightening way but an alert way. I, quite honestly, am not that concerned about the virus. These have come and gone throughout history. I am concerned about the major shift that has been taken in response to this particular one.

May God bless you and me in such a way that we are always ready and that we continue to reach out in love to those who remain separated from Christ with the Good News of His love. What an opportune time!

# School Happenings

## Preschool & K-8

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Like all of you, Trinity Lutheran School continues to adjust and adapt according to our current times. Here are some of the ways we are continuing to thrive as a virtual school setting:

- **GOD IS PRESENT.** With all of the unknowns and constant changing, it is vital that we keep God as our cornerstone in all that we do. As a staff, we begin every morning at 8:00 a.m. with our staff devotions. We meet virtually through Zoom.com to allow us the ability to have live interactions. This won't be the last time that you hear of Zoom.com. As a school, we begin each week with our Monday Morning Announcements. This is posted through Facebook Live, similar to how we have virtually gathered for church on Sundays. During our announcement time, there is a Bible verse, a reminder of weekly events, birthdays, maybe a joke or two, and we close by joining together in praying Luther's Morning Prayer. Also through Facebook Live, chapel continues to take place every Wednesday. This has been a blessing in a sense that not only are the students hearing the Chapel message, but in most cases, this has become a family event. To keep Holy Week special, our preschool staff assembled Holy Week bags for each student. These bags included a jelly bean object lesson, crafts, coloring pages, and a book. As our Zooming skills continued to increase, we supplemented our Friday Staff Devotion time to a school wide family devotion time with live interaction. **GOD IS PRESENT!**
- **COMMUNICATION is KEY.** In late March, when it was officially declared that school buildings were to be closed for the upcoming weeks, a phone call was made to each school family. This was the initial check-in to see how families were doing, and how we could support one another. Since then, we continue to communicate with families through phone calls, emails, texts, and Zooms. We also began Wednesday Parent/Teacher League (PTL) Meetings through Zoom. This has been great to have adult interaction time while planning out school events as much as possible. We've also used Friday mornings as our designated school work drop-off and pick-up. Even though it is very limited interaction to keep our distance, it is still nice to see everyone. I have to share, the first Friday after spring break, one of our students saw me and ran up to give me a hug. I tried, even though I was unsuccessful in avoiding the hug. Carter, the day is coming when we will be able to hug it out again. Hang in there, man.
- **TIMES ARE DIFFERENT, LEARNING IS DIFFERENT.** Most teachers would agree that it is much more challenging to prepare lesson plans for a substitute rather than just teaching it themselves. With the element of virtual learning, lesson planning has become that much more challenging. That being said, we are blessed to have a wonderful staff that tends to "rise to the occasion."

Like some of you, we have school families that are facing extremely difficult times. As I share with school families, please do not hesitate in letting us know how we can be of support to one another. And when it seems that we are officially in over our head, we take comfort in knowing that **GOD IS PRESENT.**

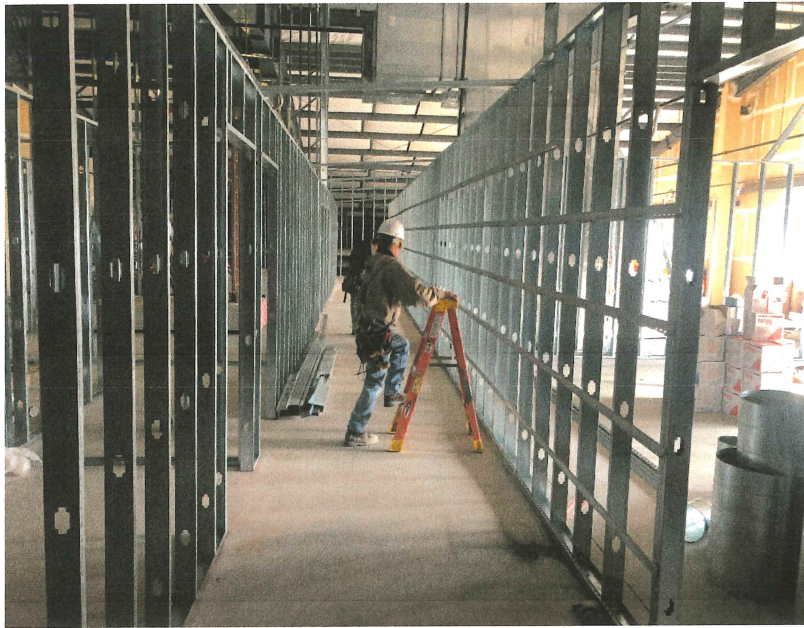

## School Upstairs Building Project:

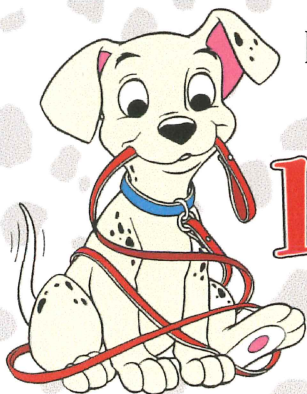
Update

## *Famous Mothers in the Bible*

Mothers are very special people. The Bible tells many stories about famous mothers.
