

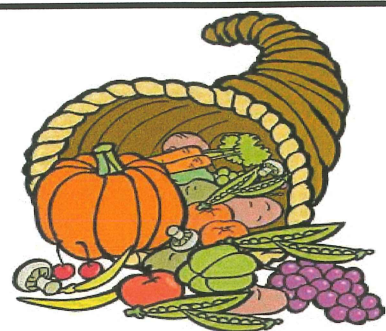

A Note from Our Church President



Trinity Family,

I want to thank everyone for their participation in the congregational meeting on Oct 11th. I appreciate District President Schlechte for providing us with information on what an Intentional Interim Pastor (IIP) does versus a vacancy Pastor.

For those that were unable attended the meeting, I want to clarify some items that may have come up recently in discussions throughout the congregation. There was a conflict between Pastor Hafeman and the Board of Elders. The conflict was regarding communication and expectations. There were no theological issues or concerns with any sermons that Pastor Hafeman gave. He served this congregation well in delivering the Word of God. At no time did the Board of Elders or any other board, call for Pastor Hafeman's resignation. I did ask Pastor Hafeman to prayerfully consider his call in our meeting the Saturday before his final sermon. I asked this, as a brother in Christ. I had no expectation of him leaving at that time. He led the membership class that I took to become a member of this congregation; he is adored by my children; his sermons and Bible studies have spiritually fed our family as it has grown, and my family will be miss him. Pastor Hafeman's decision to retire at this time, was his choice.

Following his departure, I reached out to our Rocky Mountain District for assistance. They assigned a reconciler, Pastor Schnegelberger. We continue to work with him as we move through this process. A thank you to Pastor Schnegelberger for updating the congregation on the steps that have been taken and some of the road ahead.

Many of us may be frustrated with leadership or individuals right now. I ask that we address these issues head on with one another. While the outcome of our recent conflict may not be ideal, it is where God has led us. We can only move forward by looking forward and making sure that we leave the problems of the past behind us. That doesn't mean we don't evaluate why we are here. To do that, we will need the assistance of all our congregation.

Trinity Lutheran Church and School is not "one thing" to all people. Many are served in different ways through us. Whether you come to be fed with the Word, or have a heart that wants to serve, or for the great Christian education that my family values, I give thanks to God that Trinity is here to support your needs as a family. I encourage everyone to reach out to the church leadership, myself and the Elders in particular, to let us know what we are to you and to allow us to address any of your concerns. You will be asking for your input into who we are as a congregation and what you want to see this congregation focus on as we journey forward.

As your Congregational President, I will endeavor to better communicate with you all. As we move forward, I will ensure that I have a note for you in our newsletter. I also want everyone in the congregation to feel free to reach out to me. My contact information is below. Please let me know if you have any question. If you feel you have a talent to benefit our congregation, please reach out as we can always use help in many areas.

Please continue to pray for Pastor Hafeman and Lindy, and for our congregational leadership.

October 10, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Mike Thuener. Bob Thorgesen opened with prayer.

Quorum was established. Present at the meeting were Mike Thuener, Bob Thorgesen, Dan Jecminek, Pam Clavir, Ken Clavir, Vicki Akin, & Pastor Schnegelberger.

The minutes of the September 12, 2020 council meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report - Vicki handed out the Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual Report. There are no areas of concern. The Treasurer's report was approved by the council.

Board Reports

The Board of Elders and Spiritual Ministries

1. Ken reported that the reconciliation process is proceeding in order to help the congregation.
2. DCE Angela Erickson gave a report at the meeting, and stated she is moving forward on youth programs.
 - a. She has formed a youth ministry team to assist her.
 - b. A confirmation celebration for 2020 confirmands will be held on Sunday, October 25.
 - c. As a result of the fellowship hall being used for voting, adult Bible studies will possibly continue soon after the election. Personal protection equipment will be enforced.

The Board of Property Ministries

1. Dan reported that updates were needed on the indoor sprinkler system; thus \$1,720 was paid to Front Range Fire.
2. Additional fire inspector repairs were completed.
3. A representative from Collective Sun gave a presentation on solar energy for the church and school.

The Board of Christian Education Ministries

1. Pam reported that Kindergarten is full and has a waiting list.
2. Pre-school numbers are at their maximum, given restrictions for Covid.
3. Kindergarten through eighth grades are at 47 students.
4. Parent Teacher League is moving forward with a higher member number than last year.

The Board of Financial and Stewardship Ministries

1. A group of ladies headed by Margaret Langley requested to practice hand bells on Thursday evenings. The council approved.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 10:40 a.m.

Friday, December 11, 4:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. – Cookie Baking and Decorating in the Church Kitchen

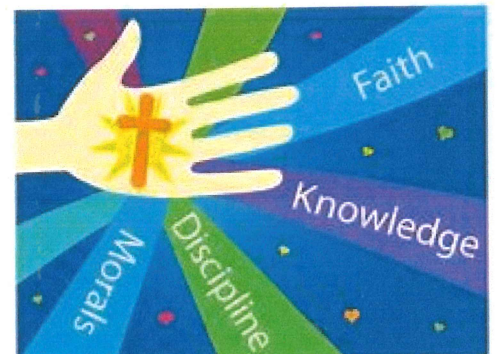
