LENT- 40 DAYS OF PREPARATION

Early in the Church's history, the major events in Christ's life were observed with special observances, such as His birth, baptism, death, resurrection and ascension.

As these observances developed, a period of time was set aside prior to the major events of Jesus' birth and resurrection as a time of preparation.

During Lent, the Church's worship assumes a more penitential character. The color for the season is purple, a color often associated with penitence. The "Hymn of Praise" is omitted from the liturgy. The word "Alleluia" is usually omitted as well.

By not using the alleluia — a joyful expression meaning "Praise the Lord" — until Easter, the Lenten season is clearly set apart as a distinct time from the rest of the year. Additionally, it forms a powerful contrast with the festive celebration of Jesus' resurrection when our alleluias ring loud and clear. Similarly, here at Trinity, we leave the altar without flowers for the 40 days of Lent and celebrate Easter Sunday with an abundance of flowers.

This focus would suggest that the season of Lent serves not only as a time to meditate on the suffering that Christ endured on our behalf but also as an opportunity to reflect upon our own Baptism and what it means to live as a child of God.

Midweek Services begin with Ash Wednesday on February 17th at 10 AM. Due to the current uncertainty of our Pastoral situation, decisions have been delayed regarding the evening service. The hope is to have a decision soon, but not before this Newsletter is published.

- 2) Label your gift with who the recipient is and who the giver is so that if your gift remains unclaimed we have someone to contact. Then follow up with your intended recipient to make sure they have been able to pick up your gift.

Accreditation will help us continue to improve, hold us accountable to standards of quality and validate the great things that are happening at Trinity Lutheran School.



The preschool just finished going through the Colorado Shines quality rating. received a 5 in staffing (which we know is the strongest aspect of our program), then 4's in family involvement and learning environment and 3's in leadership and children's health. In this system, your rating is whatever your lowest score is, so we are still a 3-star school - the same as last time - but our total points earned raised considerably from 3 years START EARLY ago. Thank you to the early childhood staff who put in the time and effort to complete QUALITY EARLY LEARNING the rating process.

It's enrollment season again! Due to Covid restrictions, we are not able to do typical open houses. But Kyle and I will work to find ways to get people in to see the school and answer questions. We updated the school brochures. You can pick up some in the office to share with those you know with preschool and elementary children. "Word of Mouth" will always be the most effective recruitment tool.




