We are able to focus on more on the woodworking business and donation platform as well as part of the plan for income in these next 4 years. God's blessings have been great and so thankful for the side jobs, health, and many great friends. School Happenings

Preschool & K-8

As I sit down to write this, we have just finished our “All Things Wheels” day. We had over 70 students on bikes, skateboards, scooters and roller blades circling the church parking lot. I’m sure the mixture of the wheels, the laughter and the praise music in the background was a joyful sound to the Lord – it definitely made my day. This is definitely an event we will want to repeat.

There are several things from this school year I DON’T want to repeat. I want to take down the quarantine calendar from my office wall. I don’t want the Health Department on speed dial. I miss having the parents walking our hallways. The practice of keeping classes in cohorts kept us healthy, but I miss the interaction between the classes.

But this Covid year brought way more blessings than burdens. Topping the list is nine students, a baby sister, and two dads baptized. Our staff had to pull together more than ever and creativity blossomed as we figured out new ways to serve our students and families. We took the first steps to get ready for National Lutheran Schools Accreditation. The elementary implemented MAP testing. The early childhood program received a Colorado Shines rating. We held our spring silent auction outdoors on May 1 and raised \$5000, almost twice what was raised our first auction attempt 2 years ago. The “Sent to Serve” quilt went for \$575. The person who purchased it plans to display it in the school until her students all graduate from Trinity (her youngest is in preschool), so you have plenty of time to come take a look. Thank you to the immensely talented and always generous Trinity Quilters for taking on this project.

We started the school year without a pastor at Trinity, but Pastor Hesse and Pastor Schnegelberger have stepped in to serve our staff and students. Both of these men are staunch supporters of Lutheran education and have been a blessing to Trinity this year.

As we look to the start of the next school year, there will be changes. Mrs. Renee Huisman is retiring, so we will need a new middle school teacher. Renee has been an incredible blessing to Trinity these past 3 years and to Lutheran education for many years. We have enough younger students that kindergarten and first grade need to be single grades, so we will have a combined second & third grade teacher joining the staff. We have a connection to get a new graduate from Concordia – Nebraska. Please pray for Rachel as she graduates and works through placement procedures. We will have a new classroom assistant in afternoon childcare starting this summer.

And we can do all this because of a couple things that do NOT change. First, we hold tightly to God’s promises and depend on His care and guidance. In my three years at Trinity, I also experienced a second thing I can count on – the prayerful, generous support of Lutheran education by the people of Trinity Lutheran Church. Your kindness and encouragement and commitment continue to amaze me.

May 8, 2021

Treasurer's Report

Vicki Akin presented the July 2020 through June 2021 Profit and Loss Budget vs. Actual financial report as well as the July 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021 income and expenses report.

Board Reports

The Board of Elders and Spiritual Ministries:

- The Elders continue to work through a re-organization process with Pastor Kent's guidance.
- A sub-committee has been formed to develop a comprehensive program for reaching out to every church member on a regular basis. With the goal of better communication with all members and follow through with the Pastor when needed.

The Board of Property Ministries

- School work day and Spring clean-up May 8, 2021.
- Jason Reiter listed several projects that will be addressed
- The janitor, Cindy Wolfe, is retiring and a couple of possible replacements are being considered
- Pastor Chris Jackson from Wisconsin will be bringing his youth group to Trinity in June as a service project. Jason, Debi and Kyle are working on a list of projects for them.
- Randy Brech wants to work on the church vegetable garden and Angela would like a pumpkin patch in the garden area. They are all working together on this project.

The Board of Christian Education Ministries

- Praise for all staff and parents who worked to keep Trinity open for in-person learning for the total school year (they said it could not be done).
- Confirmation Sunday will be May 16th during the second service with a cake reception after. The confirmands and family will enjoy a dinner on Friday night, May 14th before the confirmands present their Faith essays to family and Elders. Youth activities continue through the summer.
- VBS planned for June 21-25, 2021
- The Early Childhood Center has 31 pre-registered children for the school years starting in August.
- Trinity participated in the Children's Festival held at Island Park and gave out 530 bags with age-appropriate activities and Trinity Church and School SWAG.
- BOCE is in the process of hiring 2 new teachers, one to replace a teacher who is retiring and one new teacher because of the increase in enrollment.

The Board of Financial and Stewardship Ministries

- Budget set for Voter's meeting 1:00 pm June 6, 2021 with a time before the meeting for food and fellowship.
- Thrivent is set up to receive Appreciated stock from church members.

New Business:

- A Constitutional amendment was discussed and approved. Will be presented to the Voter's at the meeting on June 6th.

The Regular Meetings of the voters assembly shall be held quarterly, with the election of officers and board member and the transaction of other business toward the end of the Calendar Year. The approval of the fiscal budget and other business will be conducted in the 1st quarter of the Calendar Year. The 2nd and 3rd Quarter meetings will be used to conduct other business, as announced by the executive council.

Note from the Editor: When the love of my life passed away from a fast spreading cancer, it devastated my whole world. I had faith in God, but my trust was shaken. This led me on a journey of discovery. I was taught in my youth, that faith is a gift from God. Faith is knowing there is an infinite God who is all powerful, all knowing, all everything, even if I cannot see Him with my eyes. Through the spiritual gift of faith from God, I know that He exists, that He loves and cares for me, that He sent His Son to pay for my sins. But do I trust Him? Trust is a verb, an action word, it requires *me* to do something. Abraham had faith and he trusted that God would fulfill His promise even when asked to sacrifice his son Isaac. Joseph had faith and trusted God's plan when his brothers sold him into slavery. It's difficult to marry the self-preserving attitudes of this world that is full of liars, scammers, and narcissistic people, with God's desire for me to trust Him. 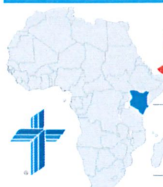

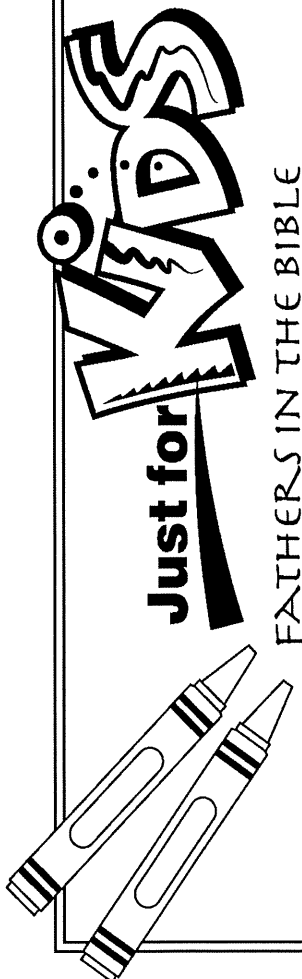

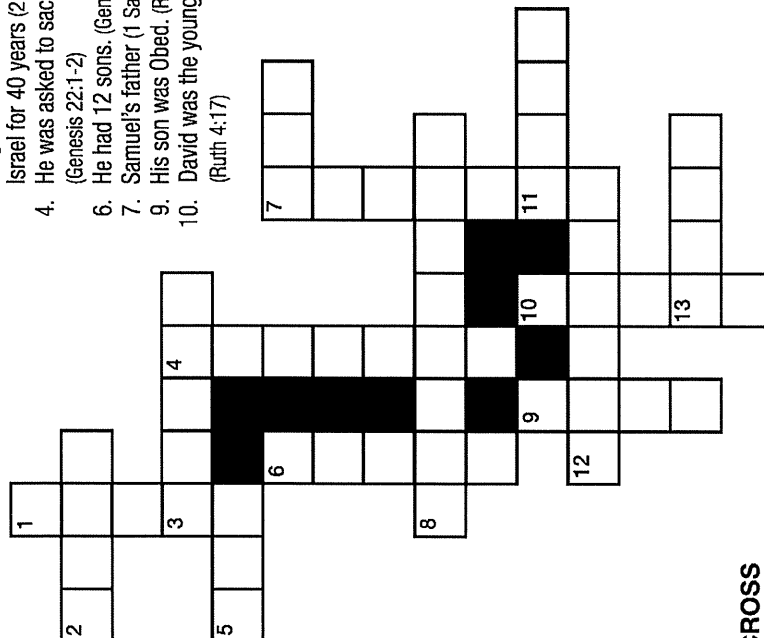
