## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



This is an exciting time of year. Advent offers members the opportunity to worship and grow in faith together here at Trinity. I heard great comments about the first seminar regarding being in the Word together. Our DCE and I

have spent time talking about how Advent can be a time for us to center on the Word while growing in fellowship with one another. Because of the timing of our Advent midweek worship services, we will be having only three because the fourth midweek is too close to Christmas. The school is going to be able to have their Christmas program on the third Wednesday, December 15. This program will be at 10:00 a.m. and then repeated at 6:30 p.m. to allow as many families as possible to be a part of the program.

We will be holding two Advent services. They will be on December 1 and 8. Our theme is "Wait Upon the Lord" There will be a 10:00 a.m. service with the school. It will be a worship designed for both the adults and the students. At 6:30 p.m. we will have a family worship. December is a busy time for many families. By serving the meal, we offer families opportunity to worship without worry about feeding the family and be at church in time. The evening service will be held in the School cafeteria. A meal will be served from 5:15 p.m. till 6:00 p.m. The meal on December 1st will be chicken, baked potato, vegetable and a light dessert. On December 8, we will serve ham, potatoes, vegetable and a light dessert. There will be a free will offering to help cover the expenses. The meal offers members an opportunity to share with one another. Following the meal, we will worship in the cafeteria around the tables. While this is called family worship, we encourage all members to be a part, since we are all one family in Christ. There will be a time to share and a craft to be done at each table.

On December 15 the meal will be in the school cafeteria from 5:15 p.m. till 6:00 p.m. Then those in attendance will make their way over to the church for Trinity School's Christmas program. We are still considering several options for the meal at this writing.

On December 19, we will hold our regular worship at 8:00 a.m. and the Sunday School Christmas service at 10:30 a.m. We are beginning to move back to some normality to our Advent and Christmas season.

On Christmas Eve, Trinity will hold services with Holy Communion, candle lighting ceremonies at 4:30 and 6:30 p.m. On Christmas Day, there will be one service at 9:00 a.m. Holy Communion will be a part of that service too.

On December 26 and January 2, there will be only one service at 9:00 a.m. On the 26<sup>th</sup>, Holy Communion will be a part of our worship. We are planning on the youth of the congregation having parts in our worship on December 26.

On New Year's Eve, December 31, we will ring in the new year with worship at 6:30 p.m. with Holy Communion.

With our Thanksgiving worship at 6:00 p.m. on November 24 through the end of the year, we have opportunities to remember the great gift God has given to all believers. We can celebrate, praise, and join as one in these celebrations.

The Sunday morning Bible Class has had some wonderful discussions about not only our relationship to God, but our relationship to one another. We plan to complete this study by Christmas. It is not too late to be a part of this.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am by Vice-President Bob Thorgesen. Pastor opened with prayer. Minutes of the October council meeting were distributed via email and approved as written.

We have scheduled one service for this Sunday, which follows Christmas Day, and are looking forward to having our youth help!

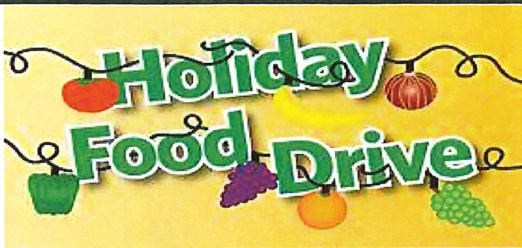
**Sunday, January 9 – Pancakes and Pajamas for Epiphany**

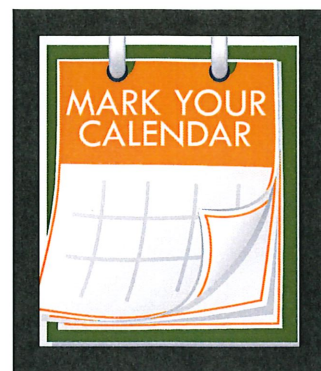

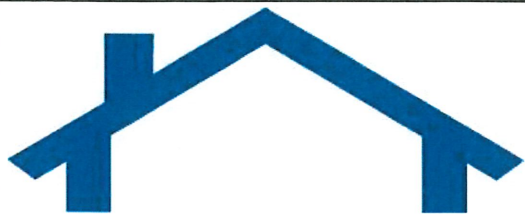

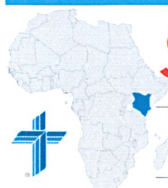
