#### LWML RMD Convention are in...

There were 167 attendees in Albuquerque. Our district's "what's your 80?" was 80 convention voters. By laws were approved and a mission goal of \$123,000 (which includes mission grants, scholarships, and mites to national). Monies were collected for mites (\$2782.64 of fering + \$157 moving for mites), the Lighthouse Mission (\$1470.50), and Tender Loving Care Community (\$1367.57), as of 6/5/22.


#### July 8-13: LC-MS Youth Gathering in Houston, Texas


